

POINT AND TELL

Building communication skills and teaching children that they have a voice is an important part of empowering them to make decisions. Children need to have the ability and confidence to communicate what they are thinking. Giving creative ways to practice communication is a fun method of building skills and showing kids they have a voice.

Pick an item:

This interactive activity may help sharpen a child's verbal communication skills. In the game, you will show your Little a random object on which they have to speak five to six lines. The object could be anything basic, like a shirt, lunchbox, or remote, etc. While talking on the topic, your Little might express knowledge about the object and feelings/thoughts that boost their confidence and enhance their vocabulary, diction, and fluency. This activity also helps in practicing the correct pronunciation of words.

Picture Storytelling:

Children love to listen to stories, and now it is their turn to narrate one. Picture storytelling is an interesting activity where a child has to narrate a story based on pictures provided to him/her. This activity helps children process visual cues and then use the interpreted information to speak. Your Little should look at the image below and tell a story about what they think is going on in the picture.
